Frank Reynolds (British, 1876-1953) was an illustrator and cartoonist trained at Heatherley's School of Fine Art. He contributed regularly to *Punch* magazine from the early 1900s and produced illustrations for books, newspapers, and wartime publications. Reynolds illustrated several editions of works by Charles Dickens for Hodder & Stoughton during the 1910s and participated in various editorial and commercial projects throughout his career in British illustrated journalism.
